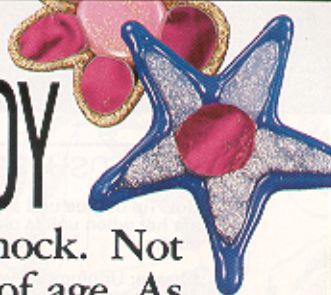

ADULT SUPERVISION SUGGESTED—Read all instructions before starting.

Hot: Tip of glue unit and glue inside are hot when unit is plugged in. Do not touch.

Always: Unplug unit when not in use. Allow items to cool before handling. Never use plugged-in unit around water at any time; never leave plugged-in unit unattended. Never carry the unit by cord or yank cord to unplug unit. Avoid accidental glue discharge. Don't carry a loaded, heated unit with your finger on the trigger.

Danger: To prevent electric shock, do not immerse unit in water. Do not use in damp locations. Do not expose to rain. We recommend that you periodically examine the toy for potential hazards and that any potentially hazardous parts be repaired or replaced.

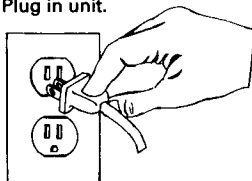

Caution: Adult supervision required. Scissors required. Covering your work surface is recommended. Do not let glue items in direct sunlight or any place which can become very hot (i.e., dark surfaces or inside closed car).

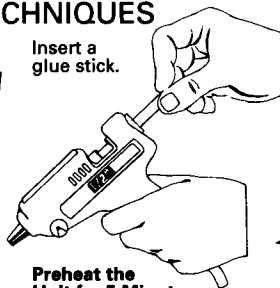


PREPARATION/TECHNIQUES

Plug in unit.

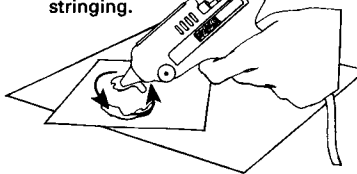


Insert a glue stick.



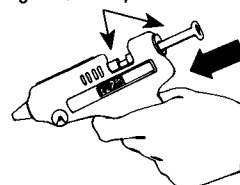
Preheat the Unit for 5 Minutes.

Squeeze trigger slowly to push glue out of unit onto workmat or surface of foil only. When you end a design, move the unit tip in small circles to prevent glue from stringing.



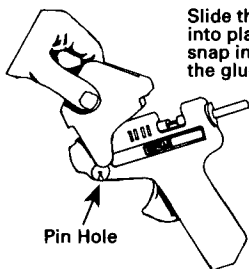
If the glue stops flowing when the trigger is pulled, insert a new glue stick or use the push rod to push the glue through the unit. **Do not** force glue stick through unit. Use **slow, steady** pressure on trigger. Keep push rod clean of glue.

Keep these areas free of glue build-up.



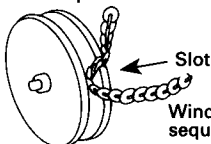
SEQUIN LOADING AND USE

Slide the sequin unit into place. The pins snap into holes on the glue unit.

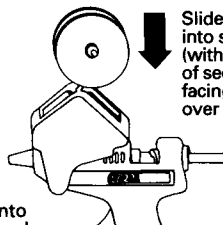


Pin Hole

Thread the sequin spool by sliding a strand of sequins into the slot on the spool.

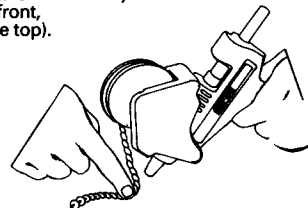


Wind the sequins onto spool, thread side down.



Slide the spool into sequin unit (with loose end of sequins facing front, over the top).

Use your free hand to press sequins into the warm glue designs you've made.



You may find it easiest to start a line of sequins by tacking the end down at the beginning of your design with a dot of glue.

When creating very complex or curvy sequin designs, you may find it easier to lay down a few inches of glue, then put the unit **down** and use both hands to apply the sequins without using the sequin spool.

Be sure to use generous amounts of glue for sequin application, and to press them into the glue firmly to be sure that they stick. Work quickly and in small areas at a time to apply sequins before glue sets.

Caution: Note to Parents

When using the electric glue unit, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock and personal injury. Not recommended for children under the age of 8 years. Read the following rules for safe operation.

- GLITZY GLU unit may reach 200 degrees F. Do not touch the tip.
- Always make sure children using the GLITZY GLU unit are supervised by an adult.
- Always follow operating instructions.
- Glue sets fast, in about 10 seconds, so plan accordingly.
- Use only GLITZY GLU special glue sticks in your GLITZY GLU unit.
- Plug the GLITZY GLU unit only into a 120 volt electrical outlet.
- Keep work areas clean and dry.
- Do not operate GLITZY GLU unit outdoors or in damp, wet locations.
- Do not use GLITZY GLU unit in presence of flammable liquids or gasses.
- Do not use extension cords with this unit.
- Keep younger children away from work area.
- Store the GLITZY GLU unit in a dry, safe area out of reach of young children when not in use.
- Never pull on cord of GLITZY GLU unit or carry unit by its cord. Inspect cord for damage frequently. Do not use GLITZY GLU unit if cord is damaged.
- Do not leave GLITZY GLU unit unattended when plugged in. Always unplug when work is complete.
- Keep GLITZY GLU unit clean. Never immerse GLITZY GLU unit in water or use liquids to clean unit.

Good Working Habits

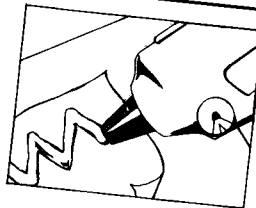
1. Get permission to work before you begin.
2. Most of the extra supplies you'll need can be found around the house. Use only EZ 2 DO GLITZY GLU glue sticks. Others may not melt and could jam unit.
Wear a smock or big, old shirt to protect your clothes. Cover your workspace, too.
4. Follow the directions carefully for each project.
5. Don't put art materials in your mouth or let a younger child do so. Keep children under 8 away from your workspace.
6. Never touch the metal tip of the unit.
7. Finish by cleaning your workspace.
8. Save these instructions for each time you start a new project.

1 EZ 2 DO BARRETTE

U•Need From Set ▶

- Clear Glue Stick ■ Hot Pink Foil Sheet
- Silver Glitter Glue Stick ■ Barrette
- Workmat

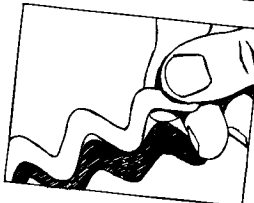
Insert clear glue stick and Preheat unit for 5 minutes.



1A. Place hot pink foil sheet, **shiny side down**, on workmat. Lightly draw a zigzag on the back of the foil (use the zigzag design shown above for size). Trace zigzag design by slowly squeezing glue out of unit. If glue stops flowing, use the push rod to push it out. Keep the tip of unit touching the foil at an angle while you work.

Cool for 2 minutes

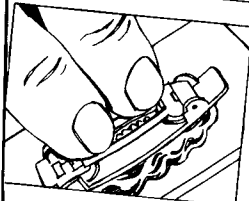
Remove from foil sheet.



1B. If you have any clear glue left in your unit, use it on another project, or push it through unit with push rod. Place silver glitter glue stick in unit and allow to heat up for 1 to 2 minutes.



1C. Place zigzag design, **shiny side down**, on workmat. Slowly fill in a rectangle around the zigzag with silver glue, being sure that some of the glue gets onto the back of the zigzag so that the zigzag and rectangle will be attached.



1D. Press the barrette (as shown) into the design while the silver glue is still warm. If the glue has already cooled, add a little more so the barrette will stick. Allow barrette to cool completely before removing from workmat.

1E. If you have any silver glitter glue left in your unit, you can use it on one of the projects in this booklet or invent one of your own.

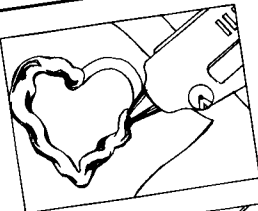

2 EZ 2 DO HEART PIN

U•Need ▶ ■ Pink Glue Stick
From Set ■ Pearl Glitter Glue Stick ■ Workmat

U•Need ▶ ■ Small Safety Pin or Jewelry Pinback
From Home

Have an adult cut the pink glue stick in half.
Insert half of pink glue stick and **Preheat unit for 5 minutes.**



2A. Place workmat over heart design (shown above). Trace the heart design by slowly squeezing the pink glue out of unit. If glue stops flowing, use the push rod to push it out.

2B. If you have any pink glue left in your unit, use it on another project, or push it through unit with push rod. Place pearl glitter glue stick in unit.

Heat for 1 to 2 minutes

2C. Fill in the inside of your heart with squiggles of pearl glue, being sure that some of the glue gets onto the back of the heart so that the two parts will be attached.

2D. Press the back of a safety pin or jewelry pinback into the design while the pearl glitter glue is still warm. If the glue has already cooled, add a little more so the safety pin or jewelry pinback will stick. Allow pin to cool completely before removing from workmat.

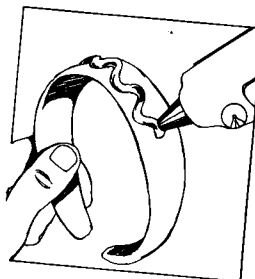
2E. If you have any pearl glitter glue left in your unit, you can use it on one of the projects in this booklet or invent one of your own.

3 EZ 2 DO GLITZY GLU HEADBAND

U•Need ▶ ■ Purple Glue Stick ■ Headband
From Set ■ Gold Glitter Glue Stick ■ Workmat

Insert purple glue stick and **Preheat unit for 5 minutes.**



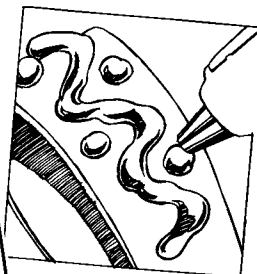
3A. Hold the headband over the workmat. Draw a squiggle design (like the one shown below) by slowly squeezing glue out of unit and onto headband. Start and end the squiggle design two inches away from the end of the headband. If glue stops flowing, use the push rod to push it out.

3B. If you have any purple glue left in your unit, use it on another project, or push it through unit with push rod. Place gold glitter glue stick in unit.

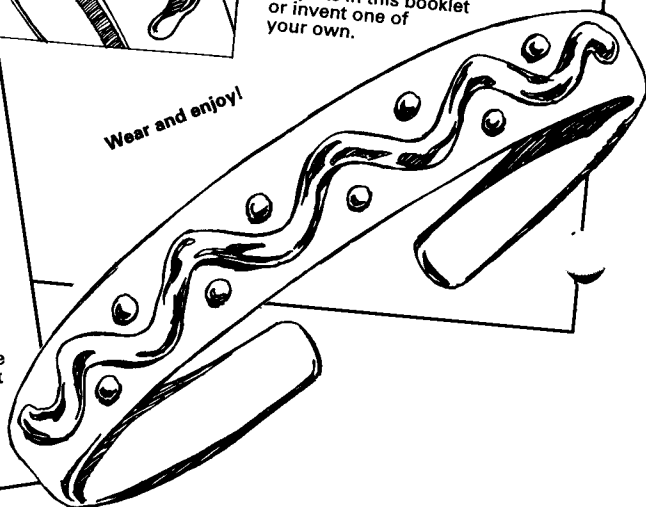
Heat for 1 to 2 minutes

Make dots of gold glitter glue on the headband. After each dot, move the unit tip in small circles to prevent glue from stringing.

3C. If you have any gold glitter left in your unit, you can use it on one of the projects in this booklet or invent one of your own.

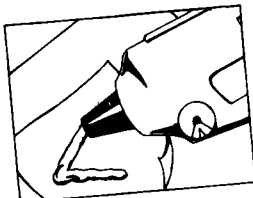


4 EZ 2 DO SPARKLING EARRINGS

U•Need
From Set

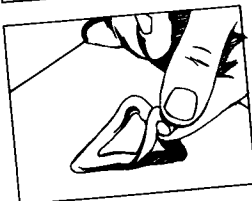
■ Clear Glue Stick ■ Silver Swirls Foil Sheet ■ Blue Glue Stick ■ Purple Foil Sheet ■ Gold Glitter Glue Stick (optional) ■ Earring Backs ■ Workmat

Have an adult cut the clear glue stick in half. Insert half of clear glue stick and **Preheat unit for 5 minutes.**



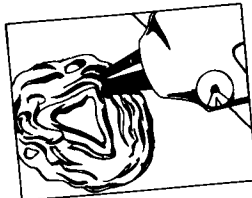
4A. Place silver foil sheet, shiny side down, on workmat. Lightly draw a triangle (use drawing above) on the back of the foil. Trace triangle outline by slowly squeezing glue out of unit. If glue stops flowing, use the push rod to push it out. Keep tip of unit touching foil at an angle while you work. Repeat to make another silver foil triangle.

Cool for 2 minutes



4B. Remove from foil sheet. If you have any clear glue left in your unit, use it on another project, or push it through unit with push rod. Place blue glue stick in unit.

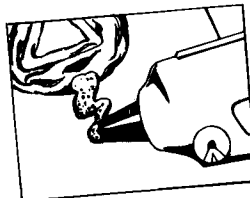
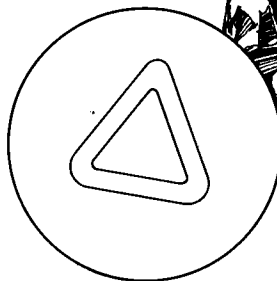
Heat 1 to 2 minutes



4C. Place purple foil sheet, shiny side down, on the workmat. Lightly draw a circle (use drawing above) on the back of the foil. Trace the circle outline with glue. Place one of the triangle designs, shiny side down, inside the circle. Slowly fill in the circle around the triangle with blue glue. Keep the tip of the unit touching the foil at an angle while you work, and be sure that some of the glue gets onto the back of the triangle so that the circle and triangle will be attached.

Cool for 2 minutes

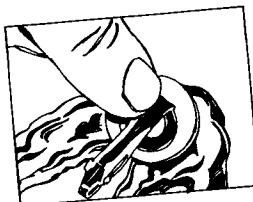
Remove from foil sheet and repeat for second triangle.



4D. A dangly part can be added to your earrings. Insert the gold glitter glue stick in the unit.

Heat 1 to 2 minutes

Keep glue designs shiny side down. Slowly push out a squiggle of glue, starting at the edge of the circle. Repeat for the other earring.



4E. Add a dab of glue to the back of one of the triangles and press the earring back into it. If you added a dangly part, make sure that the bottom of the earring back is pointed in the same direction. Repeat for the other earring. Allow earrings to cool before removing from workmat.

4F. If you have any blue or gold glitter glue left in your unit, you can use it on one of the projects in this booklet or invent one of your own.

Congratulations! Now you have a great new pair of earrings you made yourself.

5 EZ 2 DO T'S

From Set

■ Glue Sticks ■ Sequins ■ Sequin Spool ■ Workmat

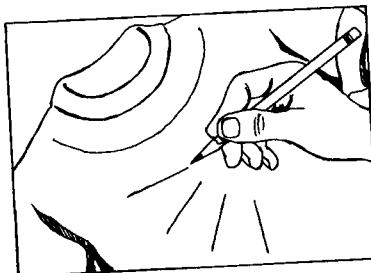
U•Need
From Home

■ Prewashed T-shirt ■ Scissors ■ Wax Paper

Insert a glue stick and **Preheat unit for 5 minutes.**

You can use your GLITZY GLU set to make your own designs with sequins and glue on: ■ hats ■ belts ■ sneakers ■ purses ■ bows ■ headbands ■ cards ■ notebooks ■ jewelry ■ almost anything!

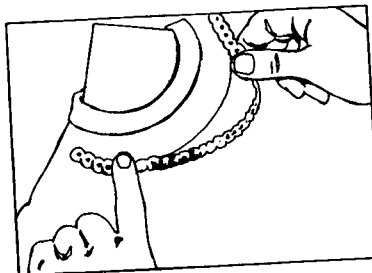
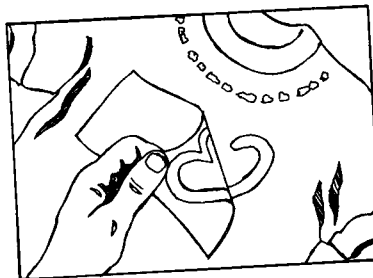
The sequin spool can also be used to hold: ■ string ■ yarn ■ ribbon



5A. Practice your design on paper first, then draw design directly onto T-shirt with pencil. Make sure you have enough sequins for your design before you begin. Select a strand of sequins and load onto sequin spool as instructed.

Important

- Glue applied without pressure will not stick to fabric. Apply pressure with finger or workmat. Pressure will spread and flatten glue.
- Glue will not stick to denim.



5B. Lay T-shirt flat and place wax paper inside shirt. Place a small amount of glue where you want to start the sequins. Press end of sequin strand, thread side down, carefully into warm glue with your finger.

Cool for 2 minutes

5C. Continue to trace 1 to 2 inches of design with glue, press the thread side of sequins carefully into the warm glue with your finger. When you've finished your design, snip end of sequins with scissors. Make sure end of the sequins is secured to fabric with a dab of glue.

5D. You can also create designs with glue only. Plan your designs in advance. Draw it on the shirt first. Trace part of your design with glue, then press it into the fabric with your fingers or workmat. If using workmat allow glue to cool for 2 minutes, then lift. Continue the rest of your design with more glue, press into fabric with fingers or workmat. Remember, glue dries more quickly than fabric paints. Wash decorated items by hand in cool water and hang or lay out on towel to dry. Do not iron, dry clean, or machine wash or dry.
