
# PLAY INSTRUCTIONS!

- 1. After you've made your Hunter and dinosaur figures, you can create action scenes and adventures with them on the play base:
  - A. Place dinosaur figures inside the snap-shut cage, then snap the cage onto the crane!
  - B. Slide the cage under the trap door on base, and capture "wild" jungle dinosaurs!
  - C. Display your Hunter and dinosaur figures in different action poses on jungle camp base!




2. When you're finished playing, you can slide the book mold underneath the base as shown, with the "rock face" side facing out. The 4 markers can be stored upright in the 4 "crater" holes on base.


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### ASSEMBLY!

- A. Press the "high hide" (tent) into its place in left front corner of play base as shown.
- B. Snap the crane into its place in right front corner of play base as shown. When in place, the crane should swivel in a complete, 360 degree turn.




## MOLD!

- 1. Take a small ball of Air Hardening Compound and roll or knead it with your fingers to soften and smooth it. Try to remove any cracks or "lines" that may be in the compound.
- 2. For best results, make one figure at a time. Place compound inside figure mold. Close and press the book mold all the way down, open it, and remove excess compound from around the figure. Then close and press the book mold down once more for best molding results.

3. Open the book mold and carefully remove the finished figure.

HINT: Tap the mold on a hard surface if the figure sticks in the mold. The mold can be washed with water to remove any residue or build-up.



### DRY!

4. When your figures are ready to dry, place them (in a standing position) out in a dry spot with circulating air (for example, a window sill or the top of a refrigerator). Recommended "drying time" is overnight, or 12 hours. NOTE: Drying time is directly affected by weather conditions. In hot or humid climates, more drying time may be needed.

### **CUSTOMIZE!**

5. When your figures are completely hard to the touch, use the markers to color, decorate and customize them in any way you want!

HINT: Color lightly, with easy pressure.
