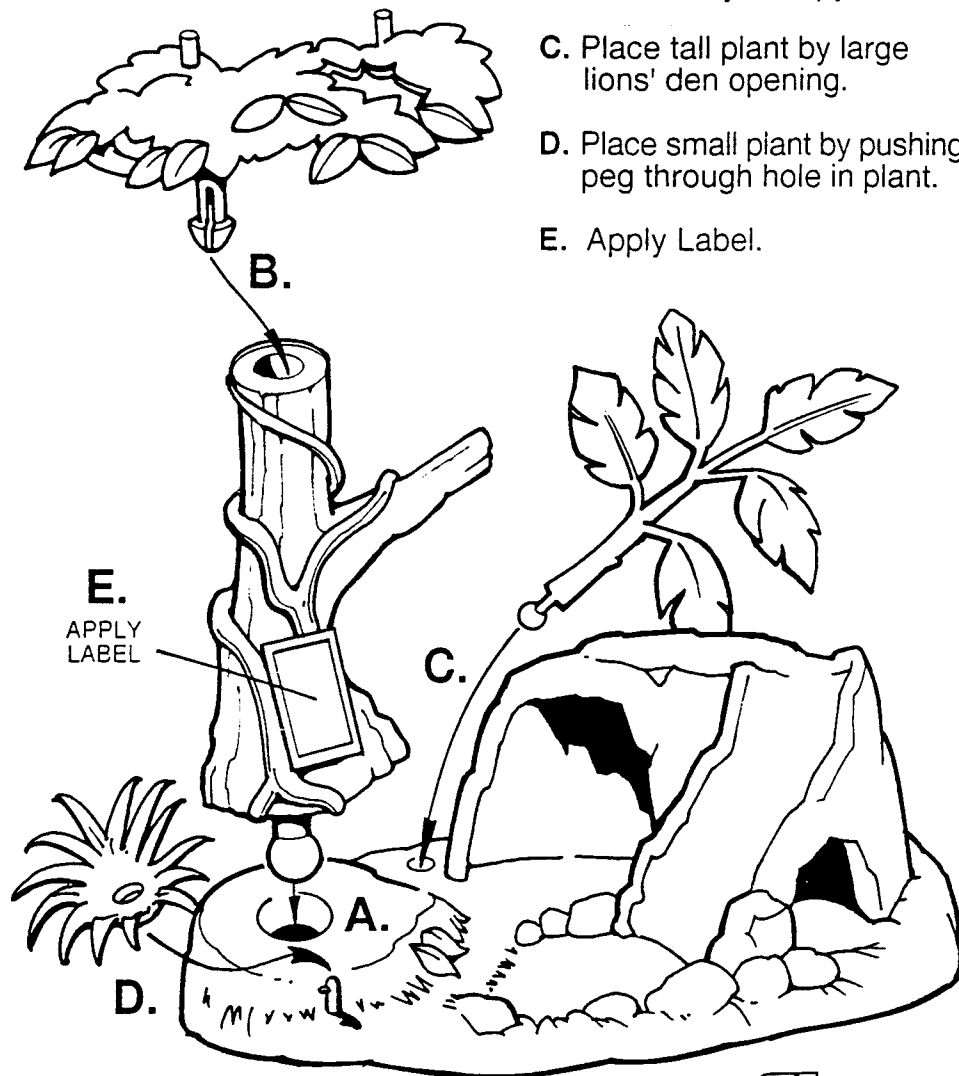




LION FAMILY

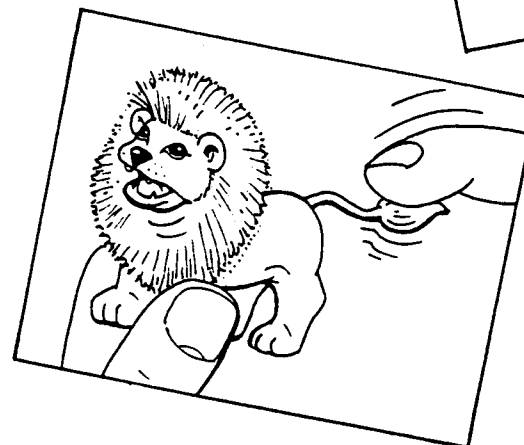
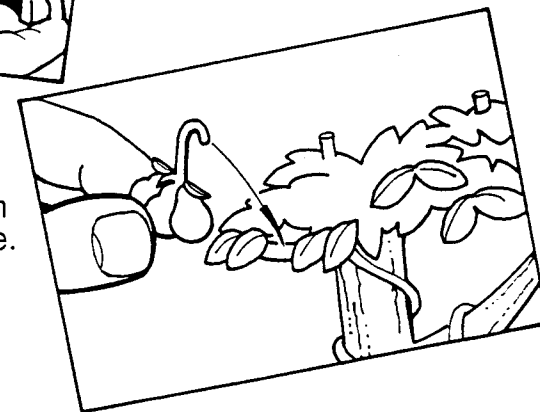
ASSEMBLY

- Press tree peg into base.
- Place leafy canopy on tree.
- Place tall plant by large lions' den opening.
- Place small plant by pushing peg through hole in plant.
- Apply Label.



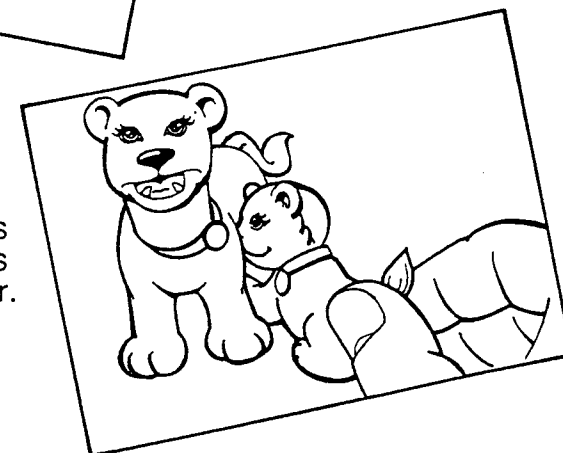
Bird can be placed on either peg of the leafy canopy or on top of the lions' den.

Hang fruit branch on the tree.



Daddy Lion opens his mouth when you press down on his tail.

Lion cub nuzzles his mother's side as he is brought close to her.
