These instructions are for Wonder World tanks of all sizes, and include an easy-to-follow chart detailing the amount of distilled water and number of Magic Gel[™] packets required for each individual tank.

Now it's time to create your own unique Wonder World™ scene...and let your imagination become reality!

Requires distilled water (see chart below for amount needed for your tank).



Each Wonder World set includes enough Magic Gel™ Powder to make 2 tankfuls of gel.





Note: Gravel must be rinsed before beginning. Place gravel in a strainer and run tap water through the strainer to rinse. Let gravel dry completely.




Distilled water must be at room temperature to make gel.

- To measure the amount of distilled water needed to make the gel, you can do either of the following:
 - A) Use a measuring cup marked with ounces; or
 - B) Pour distilled water into the tank up to the fill line as shown.
- Pour distilled water from measuring cup (or tank) into clean container that can be sealed tightly (eg. pitcher, milk jug, soda bottle, etc., depending on amount of distilled water needed). Chart indicates amount of distilled water necessary for each tank.

Important:

- If you are using a measuring cup, it could take several cupfuls of distilled water
 to reach the amount needed for the medium and large tanks. Be sure to keep
 track of how many ounces you are pouring into the container.
 Pour only the exact amount required as indicated by the chart.
- If you are pouring water from the tank into a container with a narrow opening, use a funnel to avoid spills.




3. Empty contents of Magic Gel[™] Powder packet(s) into container <u>as quickly as possible</u>. (See chart for number and size of packets needed for your Wonder World tank.)

Note: For large tanks (Ocean Wedding[™], Treasure Hunt[™]), pour powder from 3 packets into a separate cup, then pour contents of cup into the distilled water container as quickly as possible. (A dry funnel will help).


4. Seal container and immediately shake water/powder mixture for 2 minutes overall, vigorously for the first 30 seconds.

Note: Be sure container is sealed tightly. If you're using a milk jug, be sure to hold your hand over the cap to avoid spillage. For larger amounts of distilled water, it is recommended that a parent shake the container.



Immediately after you finish shaking the container, pour mixture into tank.
 (Water will be cloudy at first.)

6. Immediately add <u>rinsed</u> gravel to tank. (Unrinsed gravel will result in permanant clouding of gel.) Place cover on tank to avoid spillage. Let tank stand for a minimum of 45 minutes, at which time water should be changing into the Magic Gel. The time it takes for the water to change into gel could be longer depending on water temperature, shaking process and water/powder ratio. Wait until water is completely clear and gelled before proceeding.



1. With the tweezers, slowly place accessory pieces into the gel for imaginative scenes that are captured in suspended animation! Pieces can go anywhere, so you can create all kinds of exciting environments. (See front of package for a suggested scene.)

2. To add air bubbles to your Wonder World scene, place bubble maker into gel and squeeze handle. To remove bubbles, squeeze handle, then place bubble maker into gel, with tip near bubbles. Slowly release handle to draw the air bub-

bles out of the gel.

[If you have the Treasure Hunt™ tank, you can add pretend blood to your scene with the red coloring included in the set. Simply squeeze bubble maker handle, place tip into bottle of red coloring, then release handle to draw out coloring. Place bubble maker into gel and squeeze handle to squirt out pretend blood. Please note: Before rearranging a scene, be sure to first remove red coloring from tank to prevent coloring from spreading throughout the tank. Remove coloring the same way you removed the bubbles in step 2. The red coloring may stain certain fabrics and should be kept away from carpets and other fabric items.]



1. When the scene is complete, you can display your new creations or move the pieces around for a different look!

If you are displaying your tank:

• Be sure to keep the lid on to prevent the gel from drying.

• Maintain proper consistency of gel by adding one or two teaspoons of distilled water to the top of the gel each week.

Accessory sets are available to add to the scenes you've already

made, or to create new and exciting worlds to display!

2. To make a new tankful of gel, remove the accessories (except for the gravel) and rinse them under water to remove excess gel. Then, use a spoon, cup or container to scoop out the gel until just the gravel remains. Dispose of gel in the trash, or by pouring it down the sink drain along with running water (do not pour gravel down the drain). Scoop out the gravel and place it in a strainer. Run water through the strainer to dissolve the gel. Let gravel dry completely before reusing. Then, repeat the steps for making the Magic Gel and creating a scene for a whole

new Wonder World environment!
